



State and Ahtna request public comment in Klutina Lake Road public access lawsuit settlement



The State of Alaska and Ahtna Inc. announced Monday, July 17 that they have reached a tentative agreement in the lawsuit over public access to Klutina Lake Road. Before the agreement is finalized the parties will host a series of public comment meetings throughout the state. The parties will review the public comments and if appropriate, modify the agreement before it is finalized and signed.

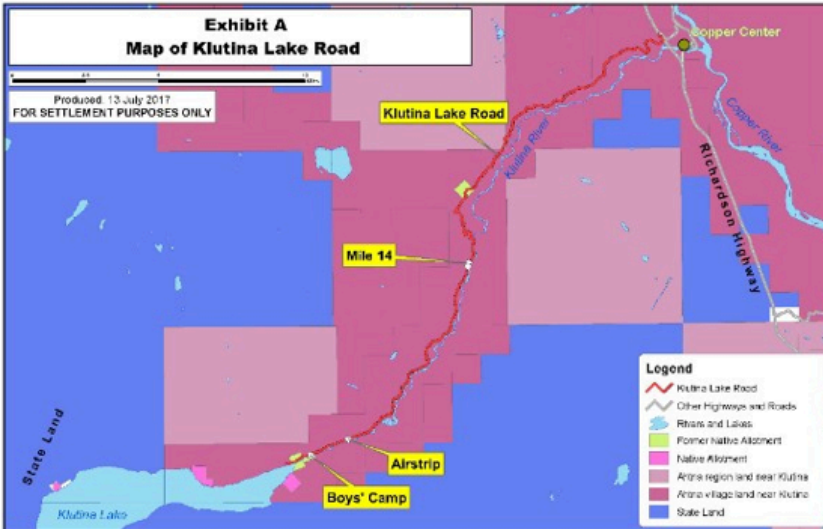
